



Ford Fiesta IV From model year 1995

Malfunction of the central locking, lever in the door handle loose.

If there are complaints with these vehicles that the lever for opening the door becomes loose in the front door handles, and that the central locking therefore sometimes does not work correctly, one possible cause is the lever having too short a fastening bolt. Due to the bolt being too short, it can slip out of the plastic guides, leading to the above-mentioned fault.

In order to eliminate the fault, the door handles must be replaced with new, modified door handles with longer bolts.
