



## ***Ford Maverick I with 2.7 TD engine***

### **Starter keeps running, ignition lock defective.**

If there are complaints with these vehicles that the starter keeps running after the ignition key is let go, then a possible cause can be a defective ignition lock. In that case, the restoring force of the ignition lock is insufficient. To eliminate the fault, the ignition lock must be replaced.

Important note:

As the ignition lock is frequently the cause of damage to or malfunction at the starter, it should as a rule be checked when repairing the starter.
