
## Noises from the heating system.

If there are complaints with these vehicles that knocking, clapping noises can be heard from the heating system when the fan is switched to stage 3 or 4, one possible reason is the temperature flap in the heating housing swinging up and down. The high air speed in fan stages 3 and 4 causes the flap to bang against the housing. The problem can be eliminated by installing a rubber stop on the setting motor of the temperature flap. To do this proceed as follows:


- Remove the glove compartment
- Remove the setting motor of the temperature flap, loosen 3 Torx screws and separate the plug-type connections.
- Push the rubber stop onto the setting motor shaft (metal disc facing the temperature flap).
- Replace the components in reverse order.

## Note:

From 06.2001 a modified temperature flap was used which prevents swinging. The necessary spare parts (rubber stop) must be purchased from Ford.
