The cause of this noise development could be the clips that were used as a mounting aid for the panorama windshield

The clips may come loose due to heat generation (insolation) for example.

Proceed as follows to rectify the problem:

 Remove the roof lining as described in the vehicle manufacturer's repair manual.

Chassis number_ CG000001 - CG107856

There have been complaints of noise in the front roof lining

Carefully loosen the clips (figure 2, position 1) using a plastic wedge (figure 2, position 2) and remove them.

Attention: do not use any sharp-edged tools!

- The fixing brackets (figure 2, position 3) can be bent downwards if required.
- Re-install the roof lining as described in the vehicle • manufacturer's repair manual.

The clips are no longer used in production as of 08/29/2012.
