



## *Renault* *All vehicle up to 12/96*

Engine doesn't crank  
Starter doesn't operate

A possible cause for this fault is a faulty connector at the solenoid starter switch. Over a period of time the connector widens and can cause contact problems. This fault can appear sporadically or permanently.

For fault diagnosis check the voltage at the connector during cranking. It must be battery voltage. If the voltage is okay, never the less, renew the connector, before removing the starter, to ensure a good contact.
