## VW Polo (6N2) Up to model year 2002

## Failure of the electric window winders.

If there are complaints with these vehicles that the electric window winder has failed, one possible cause is a defective window-winder motor. Due to excessive torque from the window-winder motor, the window pane jams at the end position, and the motor sticks. This leads to damage to the gears in the window-winder motor. In order to eliminate the fault, the window-winder motor must be replaced.

The new window-winder motors have a reduced torque and improved gears. The modified window-winder motors have been fitted as standard since March 2001 (from vehicle identification number: 6N1 265 908).
